The Code of the West

Official Gold Buckle Champion "Legends in the Making" Rules and Regulations

The Executive Committee of Gold Buckle Champion may from time to time, as necessary, adopt rules and regulations concerning the program Legends in the Making.

Entries

- Entry is open to all U.S. Citizens, of all physical abilities, race, religion or gender, aged 5 years old by March 1, 2011 and not older than 21 years of age by September 1, 2011. Proof of age must be presented with a birth certificate upon turning in the entry forms.
- No district, or county restrictions have been pre determined for 2011 calendar year.
- Entries not officially entered will not be allowed to participate in the Auction and the points earned will be voided.
- Contestants may not be related to Official entry judging committee members.
- Contestants may enter at any point in the "Legends in the Making" program from March, 2011 to July 15, 2011.
- Participants may enter activities for points that were performed before entry openings in that calendar year.
- Entries close July 15th, 2011. Entries must be post marked by July 15th, 2011 to qualify for the 2011 "Legends in the Making" program. Mail entries to: PO Box 70 Kuna, ID 83634
- All participants must have the approval of a parent or guardian if under the age of 18. All contestants must be attending school, college or continuing education program to participate.
- All Contestants must sign the Release from Liability and Waiver of Responsibility.
- If contestant is under 21 years of age, both contestant and parent or legal guardian must sign this form
- As part of this opportunity with Gold Buckle Champion, while earning points each team/individual uses ethical, and appropriate behavior while participating in the "Legends in the Making" program.
- It is the right of Gold Buckle Champion to disqualify individuals for inappropriate behavior at any place of business or any function that participates with "Legends in the Making".

Points

- All points are verified through the Gold Buckle Champions. They must be turned in by July 15th, 2011 to be counted and deemed valid towards September 2011 auction. PO Box 70 Kuna, ID 83634
- Decisions of the committee are final on all valid points accumulated
- All stamps from participating business locations are acceptable and valid for points. Have the business contact to register with Gold Buckle Champion if they do not have official forms.
- All hand written signatures must be followed by proven documents from that organization of service performed. Photos, certificates, and awards, are acceptable proof of performance. Copies of originals will be accepted.
- Participants must be present at time of live auction.
- All points, Valid or Invalid, have zero dollar value.
- All points are null and void after the auction. Each year points start fresh; there are no accumulated points into the next program year except that each participant will receive a certificate of participation that will be worth 50 points for the following year.
- Points are nontransferable, but individuals may group their points together for a common cause :ie sport uniforms, field trips, school computers, etc.

Auction

- Participants must be present at time of live auction to use their points.
- Auction items can only be bought with points, no cash will be transferred, and points have zero cash value.
- Auction items will be listed prior to the Auction on www.GoldBuckleChampion.com
- Items donated with restrictions will be announced as such and marked accordingly. ie: items donated for a team or school can only be bought to go to a team or school. Individuals will be able to form teams to purchase these and combine points as necessary.
